



Founded 1751 in Rotherham, Beatson Clark began supplying quality glass bottles to chemists and apothecaries

Its early reputation for precision and reliability helped establish it as a cornerstone of Britain's packaging industry.

Beatson Clark adapted its operations to support the war effort. In WW1, many women joined the workforce in roles such as the warehouse and stoppering shop

By WW2, women outnumbered men at the Stairfoot site, taking on production roles while men served in the military.

The company also manufactured glass containers for armaments and medical

supplies

Recognising the need to diversify, Beatson Clark expanded its product range during the 1970s & 80s to serve the food and beverage industries

This strategic move allowed the company to tap into new markets, offering glass packaging solutions for a variety of consumable goods and marked a significant shift in its business operations

Continuing its commitment to innovation, Beatson Clark has recently introduced new design services, including bespoke embossing and decoration options, catering to niche brands worldwide

Beatson has also increased its global footprint, exporting approximately 20% of products




Beatson Clark has seen consistent financial momentum, with revenue growing from £55.5m in FY18 to a high of £86.6m in FY23. Strong profit growth has accompanied this rise.

Supported by a strengthened balance sheet, with net assets nearly tripling from £28.5m to £86.2m,







Today, Rollalong stands as the South's largest offsite design and build contractor, delivering modular buildings across residential, defence, education and healthcare sectors



Qdos introduced sustainable modular buildings, including the solar powered Containex range, and launched the premium plus line.





In November 2020, Gowrings Mobility acquired Bristol Street Versa, forming GowringsVersa Mobility


This merger expanded the company's product range and customer base, reinforcing its position as a leading WAV converter in the UK





Embracing the future of transportation, AVH has begun integrating eco-friendly vehicles into its fleet, focusing on sustainability without compromising accessibility



By 1900, it expanded into producing branded garden tools, which gained popularity and were sold through major retailers like Woolworths Post WW2, Jenks & Cattell became the UK's largest manufacturer of light washers and pressings

The company diversified its production to include automotive components, brake drums, gramophones and parts for aircraft and ships. By 1961, it employed over 850 workers, reflecting significant growth

In the early 1980s, the company was among the UK's largest garden tool manufacturers

1986 - Newship acquires the company and rebrand it to Jenks and Cattell Engineering Ltd.

1990 - The company achieved BS 5750 accreditation

1999 - Began exporting to Europe and South America

Jenks & Cattell invested in advanced manufacturing technologies, including robotic welding and CNC machining

2021 - Introduction of the "Target Zero" philosophy, aiming for zero defects, accidents, variance and landfill.





James Gibbons established a workshop in Wolverhampton in 1670, quickly earning a reputation for superior craftsmanship

His ironmongery adorned prestigious projects, including Sir Christopher Wren's architectural works. by the late 19th century, Gibbons was recognised as Britain's oldest lockmaker

Bennetts began as Weatherhead Walters & Son in 1734 on Irongate, Derby. Under George Bennett's leadership from 1864, the company expanded its offerings to include agricultural tools, sports equipment, and homewares

The store's unique ship like design and diverse product range made it a local landmark

Post WW2, both companies navigated industry shifts

James Gibbons Format contributed to significant projects like the Barbican Centre and the Channel Tunnel

Bennetts continued to expand its retail presence and maintaining it's status as a trusted supplier

James Gibbons Format and Bennetts were integrated together under Newship Group


